ADVENTURE AND LEISURE ACTIVITIES

CASE STUDY – A SUCCESSFUL MORNINGTON PENINSULA EVENT

ST JOSEPH'S PRIMARY SCHOOL ELSTERNWICK RETURNS FOR SECOND CONFERENCE

The appeal of a conference venue near the beach and the quality of facilities and services on the Mornington Peninsula saw St Joseph's Primary School Elsternwick return in March 2017 for its second school conference.

Business Events Mornington Peninsula received their enquiry in July 2016 and immediately forwarded it to suitable venues. By close of business the same day, the school had received two proposals.

The school had previously booked in Sorrento and, choosing to stay in the southern Peninsula again, this time booked the Portsea Village Resort.

Around 30 delegates attended the event, which comprised a morning conference, lunch, free afternoon and Hollywood themed dinner on day 1, and a morning conference on day 2.

Moira McKinnis, St Joseph's Finance and Administration Officer, said the school was very happy with the service provided by Business Events Mornington Peninsula and the Portsea Village Resort.

"The organisation was good, we had a nice conference room overlooking the pool, the guest rooms were great and the resort was a good size for us.

"The resort staff were very helpful in getting everything ready, particularly in meeting our technical and room set-up requirements," she said.

On the free afternoon, delegates made the most of the resort's proximity to a number of local attractions, splitting into groups for swimming, shopping in Sorrento, walking in the Point Nepean National Park or relaxing at the famous Portsea Hotel on the beach.
